THIS TRAINING CONTRACT is made and entered into on this _____ day of _____, 20_____, by and between Mitch and JoLinn Hoover, the "Trainer", and _____, the "Owner", and if the Owner is a minor, Owner's Parent or guardian _____

Trainer agrees to except Owner's horse _____,
Breed _____, Reg. No. _____, Color _____, Age _____,
for training and it is the plan and intention of the Owner to place this horse into training.

For and in consideration of mutual agreements, hereinafter the Owner and Trainer mutually agree as follows:

- 1) Owner shall pay the Trainer for professional services as described below (check one):
 - *stall board is payable directly to OHC as per their board contract
 - *Due to the in-depth aspects of our unique program, Training rates are based on a 3 week per month/4 day per week average. There are reasons for this; please talk to us if this is unclear!!
 - _____ \$ 600/Month - No Cattle Work, No travel (all work is performed on site only)
 - _____ \$ 700/Month - Training on cattle: including moving, herding, sorting, roping, cutting.
 - _____ \$ 700/Month - Travel Experience Training or Show Training; additional charges apply.
 - \$250.00** \$ 250/ Month - Full Care Service only; (separate stall rent is payable directly to OHC as per their board contract)
 - *Includes hay, stall cleaning, turnouts. Horse may be put on full care rate in the event trainer is away for extend times or horse becomes sick or injured. Does not include special grooming requests, clipping, show prep.
 - _____ \$30/Month - Daily feed mix; we will feed your **pre-bagged** mix at no additional charge

See Rate card for charges in addition to training fees and normal care services.
- 2) All training fees are to be paid in advance (the date of this contract) unless prior agreements are made for payment terms. Billing procedure as follows: When horse arrives, the 1st month is to be paid in advance. The second month billings are brought up to the 1st, if necessary, then billed monthly on the 1st to be paid before the 10th of each month. Veterinary, shoeing or any other service or expense will be billed monthly.
- 3) In the event that payment of services is overdue by 45 days, the Trainer is entitled to a lien against the horse for the amount due and shall enforce the lien and sell the horse for the amount due according to the appropriate laws of the state.
- 4) A horse will not be released from Trainer's possession until all expenses are paid in full.
- 5) A horse will not be released from Trainer's possession until owner has spent no less than two ours in lessons on the horse with the Trainer. If the situation arises that this cannot be accomplished the owner will be required to sign a disclaimer which states their refusal to complete lessons and releases the Trainer and Facility from responsibility once the horse leaves the Trainer's possession. Two hours of free lessons per month are included in the training fee. Additional lessons may be scheduled at the current lessons rate.
- 6) If a horse is taken out of training by the Owner before the training contract is up, there will be no money refunded.
- 7) In case of sickness or injury to horse in training, and the horse becomes unfit to ride, remaining training fees paid will first be applied as credit towards board, vet, medical, etc.. Any balance will be refunded to the Owner.

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2014 Horse Training Rates

Due to the nature of our in-depth program, we do not take horses in training for less than sixty days. We intentionally keep our training horse numbers low and strive for a ten head limit with two riders.

Full Service fees include: Good quality hay and/or pasture and salt/mineral block or free choice. All other expenses will be billed including but not limited to; shoeing, vaccines, worming, vet care, supplements. **Additional lessons** may be purchased at the regular lesson rate listed below. In addition to lesson time, we encourage owners to come often to observe the progress of their horse. Observations are not charged for and are a good tool to enhance the investment you are making in your horse. Instruction given during the horse's **regular work-time** are not charged for providing the time does not exceed the normal "work".

\$600 per month - No cattle work or travel training of any kind.

\$700 per month - Training on cattle:

May include tracking & rating, basic ranch cutting maneuvers, roping (arena & ranch), alley and gate sorting, moving between pastures, and more.

\$700 per month - Travel Experience Training:

For those wanting their horse seasoned to travel we will include them on our trips and use them in our clinics and ranch work such as brandings, and more. Rates are listed below for those who want show experience on their horse. Additional applicable charges for Travel Training will include stalls, cattle charge, facility charge, grooming, stall cleaning, etc., see rates below. Only four horses at a given time will be accepted into Travel Exp. Training at a time

Other Services:

Full Care Service Only: \$250/month; feeding, stall cleaning, turnout, normal grooming

*does not include stall rent, grain mix, special grooming/care requirements

Supplement Feeding: \$30/month if not provided by owner. **Must be pre-packaged if owner provided!**

Blanketing 2x daily: \$2/day

Special Vet Care: \$15/day minimum (price dependent upon extent of care required)

Hauling: \$100 minimum (.65 per mile round trip after 100 mi.)

Extra Lesson/Ride \$55/hr

Horse Show charges:

Schooling: Limited classes (non-schooling rates on a case by case basis, talk to us individually)

\$100 - One day show

\$75 - per day/multi day show

Tack Room Stalls: Fee split up between all horses

Bedding: Split up between all horses

Grooming: \$60 day/includes clipping, bathing, daily show grooming, tack prep & cleaning, tacking & un-tacking, blanketing.

Day Fee: \$20 day/includes feeding and stall cleaning only on days not shown.

Travel Expenses: Split up between all horses; fuel & meals.

Motel or RV space: Split up between all horses.

Entry Fees, Stall Fee, & Cattle Charges: To be paid in full by the owner by show deadline date.

Sale Commission Fee:

Varies on a case to case basis. Please talk to us regarding how we can help you find or sell your horse.

Groups over 5 riders constitute a clinic; see clinic rates. All lessons not scheduled at ranch or not at a location we are already at will assess additional travel expenses at .55/mile. Most lessons are not on a strict hourly schedule, rather, the need of the moment dictates the lesson length. This is a general guideline.

Coaching & Consulting

Additional charges include all travel expenses (fuel, flight, meals, motel) unless at an event we are already scheduled for (some coaching included for training customers and are on a case by case rate, see us for this service).

Shows, Competitions, or Ranch Consulting: unless stated below the hourly rate is \$55/hr

Exclusive (no other riders may use Hoovers if scheduled for an Exclusive)

\$400/day Coaching days — includes all aspects of the event attending including pre-class preparation, walk-through strategies for trail or reining, mental preparation, and over-all show prep.

\$250/day Travel days— days spent traveling to and from event attending. Student also furnishes all travel expenses; plane tickets, vehicle fuel, meals, motels, and such.

Per Class - (fee is offered only at events we are already scheduled to attend).

\$30 - 45 minute max.; includes 10 minute pre-class, & 10 minute post-class conference and assessment.

Phone Coaching & Consulting

\$55/hr. (\$30 minimum) - includes pre-show class assessment, class strategies, rule analysis, attire, and more. Also includes training questions and prior preparation suggestions for your horse, and more.

Video Critique— \$30/hr

Schedule a video viewing appointment for a location we are at or send us your show or training video and we will assess the strengths and weaknesses in your content. Fee includes verbal summarization with you to formulate a plan to help attain your goals.



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
